Gen. 4:16 Then Cain went out from the presence of the Lord and dwelt in the land of Nod on the east of Eden.

Ez. 28:12 King of Tyre: We are going to see that the King of Tyre is a typology of Satan-and once again, he was in Eden, with Adam and Eve. Can Satan come here? Who does he have to give his power to in the end times? Why? The evil powers must possess people or animals to come here. You were the seal of perfection, full of wisdom and perfect in beauty. You were in Eden, I don't see direct communication in this realm as we do in the Old Testament such as Adam and Eve in the Garden. - Jer. 18:17 'Like an east wind I will scatter them before the enemy I will show them My back and not My face
- **Isaiah 27:8** You contended with them by banishing them, by driving them away. With His fierce wind He has expelled them on the day of the east wind.
- Job 27:21 "The east wind carries him away, and he is gone, For it whirls him away from his place.
- **Zech. 8:7** I added this one in here. Thus says the Lord of hosts, 'Behold, I am going to save My people from the land of the east and from the land of the west;

Rev. 16:12 Then the sixth angel poured out his bowl on the great river **Euphrates** what is the River Euphrates connected to from a river that splits into four rivers?, and its water was dried up, so that the way of the kings from the **east** where is that? might be prepared. The two realms open up to one another again during the 'hour', specifically during the 6th Bowl.

Rev. 9:14 saying to the sixth angel who had the trumpet, "Release the four angels who are bound at the great river **Euphrates**." ¹⁵ So the four angels, who had been prepared for the hour and day and month and year, were released to kill a third of mankind.

Is. 11:15-16 And the LORD will utterly destroy the tongue of the Sea of Egypt; And He will wave His hand over the River with His scorching wind; And He will strike it into seven streams And make *men* walk over dry-shod. And there will be a highway from Assyria for the remnant of His people who will be left, just as there was for Israel in the day that they came up out of the land of Egypt.

4. ASSYRIA/ASSYRIANS

Is. 27:12-13 In that day the Lord will start His threshing from the flowing stream of the Euphrates to the brook of Egypt, and you will be gathered up one by one, O sons of Israel. It will come about also in that day that a great trumpet will be blown, and those who were perishing in the land of **Assyria** who were scattered in the land of **Egypt** will come and worship the Lord in the holy mountain at Jerusalem.

Zechariah "When I scatter them among the peoples, they will remember Me in far countries, and they with their children will live and come back. "I will bring them back from the land of Egypt and gather them from Assyria; And I will bring them into the land of Gilead and Lebanon Until no room can be found for them. "And they will pass through the sea of distress and He will strike the waves in the sea, so that all the depths of the Nile will dry up; And the pride of Assyria will be brought down and the scepter of Egypt will depart.

Is. 10:12 So it will be that when the Lord has completed all His work on Mount Zion and on Jerusalem, He will say, "I will punish the fruit of the arrogant heart of the king of Assyria and the pomp of his haughtiness."

Isaiah 19 Septuagint: THE VISION OF EGYPT. Behold, the Lord sits on a swift cloud, and shall come to Egypt: and the idols of Egypt shall be moved at his presence, and their heart shall faint within them. 2And the Egyptians shall be stirred up against the Egyptians: and a man shall fight against his brother, and a man against his neighbor, city against city, and law against law.

- 3And the spirit of the Egyptians shall be troubled within them; and I will frustrate their counsel: and they shall enquire of their gods and their images, and them that speak out of the earth, and them that have in them a divining spirit.
- 4And I will deliver Egypt into the hands of men, of cruel lords; and cruel kings shall rule over them: thus saith the Lord of hosts.
- 5And the Egyptians shall drink the water that is by the sea, but the river shall fail, and be dried up. 6And the streams shall fail, and the canals of the river; and every reservoir of water shall be dried up, in every marsh also of reed and papyrus.
- 7And all the green herbage round about the river, and everything sown by the side of the river, shall be blasted with the wind and dried up.
- **8**And the fishermen shall groan, and all that cast a hook into the river shall groan; they also that cast nets, and the anglers shall mourn.
- 9And shame shall come upon them that work fine flax, and them that make fine linen.
- <u>10</u>And they that work at them shall be in pain, and all that make beer shall be grieved, and be pained in their souls.
- 11 And the princes of Tanis shall be fools: *as for* the king's wise counsellors, their counsel shall be turned into folly: how will ye say to the king, we are sons of wise men, sons of ancient kings?
- 12Where are now thy wise men? and let them declare to thee, and say, What has the Lord of hosts purposed upon Egypt?
- 13 The princes of Tanis have failed, and the princes of Memphis are lifted up *with pride*, and they shall cause Egypt to wander by tribes.

- 14For the Lord has prepared for them a spirit of error, and they have caused Egypt to err in all their works, as one staggers who is drunken and vomits also.
- 15And there shall be no work to the Egyptians, which shall make head or tail, or beginning or end. 16But in that day the Egyptians shall be as women, in fear and in trembling because of the hand of the Lord of hosts, which he shall bring upon them. 17And the land of the Jews shall be for a terror to the Egyptians: whosoever shall name it to them, they shall fear, because of the counsel which the Lord of hosts has purposed concerning it.
- 18 In that day there shall be five cities in Egypt speaking the language of Chanaan, and swearing by the name of the Lord of hosts; one city shall be called the city of Asedec.
- 19In that day there shall be an altar to the Lord in the land of the Egyptians, and a pillar to the Lord by its border. 20And it shall be for a sign to the Lord for ever in the land of Egypt: for they shall presently cry to the Lord by reason of them that afflict them, and he shall send them a man who shall save them; he shall judge and save them. 21And the Lord shall be known to the Egyptians, and the Egyptians shall know the Lord in that day; and they shall offer sacrifices, and shall vow vows to the Lord, and pay *them*. 22And the Lord shall smite the Egyptians with a stroke, and shall completely heal them: and they shall return to the Lord, and he shall hear them, and thoroughly heal them.
- 23In that day there shall be a way from Egypt to the Assyrians, and the Assyrians shall enter into Egypt, and the Egyptians shall go to the Assyrians, and the Egyptians shall serve the Assyrians.
 24In that day shall Israel be third with the Egyptians and the Assyrians, blessed in the land which the Lord of hosts has blessed,25saying, Blessed be my people that is in Egypt, and that is among the Assyrians, and Israel mine inheritance.
- Is. 14:24-27 **24**Thus saith the Lord of hosts, As I have said, so it shall be: and as I have purposed, so *the matter* shall remain: **25***even* to destroy the Assyrians upon my land, and upon my mountains: and they shall be for trampling; and their yoke shall be taken away from them, and their glory shall be taken away from their shoulders. **26**This is the purpose which the Lord has purposed upon the whole earth: and this the hand that is uplifted against all the nations. **27**For what the Holy God has purposed, who shall frustrate? and who shall turn back his uplifted hand?
- Is. 11:16 And there will be a highway from Assyria For the remnant of His people who will be left, Just as there was for Israel In the day that they came up out of the land of Egypt.
- Is. 19:23-25 In that day there will be a highway from Egypt to Assyria, and the Assyrians will come into Egypt and the Egyptians into Assyria, and the Egyptians will worship with the Assyrians. In that day Israel will be the third party with Egypt and Assyria, a blessing in the midst of the earth, whom the Lord of hosts has blessed, saying, "Blessed is Egypt My people, and Assyria the work of My hands, and Israel My inheritance."
- Is. 20:4-6 so the king of Assyria will lead away the captives of Egypt and the exiles of Cush, young and old, naked and barefoot with buttocks uncovered, to the shame of Egypt. Then they will be dismayed and ashamed because of Cush their hope and Egypt their boast. So the

inhabitants of this coastland will say in that day, 'Behold, such is our hope, where we fled for help to be delivered from the king of Assyria; and we, how shall we escape?'"

5. WILDERNESS

Ezekiel 20:33 ³³ As I live, saith the Lord God, surely with a mighty hand, and with a stretched out arm, and with fury poured out, will I rule over you: ³⁴ And I will bring you out from the people, and will gather you out of the countries wherein ye are scattered, with a mighty hand, and with a stretched out arm, and with fury poured out during Bowl 6 - key word is POURED to know it is the Bowls. ³⁵ And I will bring you into the wilderness of the peoples, and there will I plead with you face to face This is where the Millennial Reign people will be - when he feeds them in the wilderness for 1,260 years according to the Book of Revelation. ³⁶ Like as I pleaded with your fathers in the wilderness that was another forshadowing, when GOD gave His law to the Israelites of the land of Egypt, so will I plead with you, saith the Lord God. ³⁷ And I will cause you to pass under the rod under the rule of Jesus - he will rule with a rod of iron, and I will bring you into the bond of the covenant we will be taught the Way: ³⁸ And I will purge out from among you the rebels, and them that transgress against me they will not be permitted to enter the Promised Land, just as the Israelites were not permitted, just their children and Joshua and Caleb: I will bring them forth out of the country where they sojourn, and they shall not enter into the land of Israel this is Zion, the land of Israel means the land of the Israel people - no one who is disobedient to the law will be able to enter the land - this will be another time of testing: and ye shall know that I am the Lord. ³⁹ As for you, O house of Israel, thus saith the Lord God; Go ye, serve ye every one his idols, and hereafter also, if ye will not hearken unto me: but pollute ye my holy name no more with your gifts, and with your idols. ⁴⁰ For in mine holy mountain, in the mountain of the height of Israel this is Mt. Zion, saith the Lord God, there shall all the house of Israel, all of them in the land, serve me: there will I accept them, and there will I require your offerings, and the firstfruits of your oblations, with all your holy things. ⁴¹ I will accept you with your sweet savor, when I bring you out from the people, and gather you out of the countries wherein ye have been scattered; and I will be sanctified in you before the heathen. We will learn the law. 42 And ye shall know that I am the Lord, when I shall bring you into the land of Israel this is Zion, the land of the people called Israel, into the country for which I lifted up mine hand to give it to your fathers.

⁴³ And there shall ye remember your ways, and all your doings, wherein ye have been defiled; and ye shall loathe yourselves in your own sight for all your evils that ye have committed.

⁴⁴ And ye shall know that I am the Lord when I have wrought with you for my name's sake, not according to your wicked ways, nor according to your corrupt doings, O ye house of Israel because we are taught in this realm we don't have to obey GOD's law, saith the Lord God.

⁴⁵ Moreover the word of the Lord came unto me, saying, ⁴⁶ Son of man, set thy face toward the south, and drop thy word toward the south, and prophesy against the forest of the south field;

⁴⁷ And say to the forest of the south, Hear the word of the Lord; Thus saith the Lord God;

Behold, I will kindle a fire in thee, and it shall devour every green tree in thee, and every dry tree: the flaming flame shall not be quenched, and all faces from the south to the north shall be burned therein. ⁴⁸ And all flesh shall see that I the Lord have kindled it: it shall not be quenched. ⁴⁹ Then said I, Ah Lord God! they say of me, Doth he not speak parables?

Ez. 34:22-31 ²² Therefore will I save my flock, and they shall no more be a prey; and I will judge between cattle and cattle. ²³ And I will set up one shepherd over them, and he shall feed them even my servant David; he shall feed them, and he shall be their shepherd. ²⁴ And I the Lord will be their God, and my servant David a prince among them; I the Lord have spoken it. ²⁵ And I will make with them a covenant of peace, and will cause the evil beasts to cease out of the land: and they shall dwell safely in the wilderness, and sleep in the woods. ²⁶ And I will make them and the places round about my hill a blessing; and I will cause the shower to come down in his season; there shall be showers of blessing. ²⁷ And the tree of the field shall yield her fruit, and the earth shall yield her increase, and they shall be safe in their land, and shall know that I am the Lord, when I have broken the bands of their yoke, and delivered them out of the hand of those that served themselves of them. ²⁸ And they shall no more be a prey to the heathen, neither shall the beast of the land devour them; but they shall dwell safely, and none shall make them afraid. ²⁹ And I will raise up for them a garden of renown, and they shall be no more consumed with hunger in the land, neither bear the shame of the heathen anymore. ³⁰ Thus shall they know that I the Lord their God am with them, and that they, even the house of Israel, are my people, saith the Lord God. ³¹ And ye my flock, the flock of my pasture, are men, and I am your God, saith the Lord God.

Rev. 12:6-13 ¹³ And when the dragon saw that he was cast unto the earth, he persecuted the woman which brought forth the man child. ¹⁴ And to the woman were given two wings of a great eagle, that she might fly into the wilderness, into her place, where she is nourished for a time, and times, and half a time, from the face of the serpent. ¹⁵ And the serpent cast out of his mouth water as a flood after the woman, that he might cause her to be carried away of the flood. ¹⁶ And the earth helped the woman, and the earth opened her mouth, and swallowed up the flood which the dragon cast out of his mouth. ¹⁷ And the dragon was wroth with the woman, and went to make war with the remnant of her seed, which keep the commandments of God, and have the testimony of Jesus Christ.

Ex. 4:27 Septuagint 27And the Lord said to Aaron, Go into the wilderness to meet Moses; and he went and met him in the mount of God, and they kissed each other. 28And Moses reported to Aaron all the words of the Lord, which he sent, and all the things which he charged him. 29And Moses and Aaron went and gathered the elders of the children of Israel. 30And Aaron spoke all these words, which God spoke to Moses, and wrought the miracles before the people. 31and the people believed and rejoiced, because God visited the children of Israel, and because he saw their affliction: and the people bowed and worshipped.

Ex. 14:2-3 Septuagint <u>3</u>For Pharaoh will say of the Israelites, 'They are wandering the land in confusion; the wilderness has boxed them in.' <u>4</u>And I will harden<u>a</u> Pharaoh's heart so that he will pursue them. But I will gain honor by means of Pharaoh and all his army, and the Egyptians will know that I am the LORD."

Ex. 16:1 Septuagint 1On the fifteenth day of the second month after they had left the land of Egypt, the whole congregation of Israel set out from Elim and came to the Desert of Sin, a which is between Elim and Sinai. 2And there in the desert the whole congregation of Israel grumbled against Moses and Aaron. 3"If only we had died by the LORD's hand in the land of

- Egypt!" they said. "There we sat by pots of meat and ate our fill of bread, but you have brought us into this desert to starve this whole assembly to death!"
- Ex. 5:1-3 Afterward Moses and Aaron went in and told Pharaoh, "Thus says the Lord God of Israel: 'Let My people go, that they may [a]hold a feast to Me in the wilderness.' "

 And Pharaoh said, "Who is the Lord, that I should obey His voice to let Israel go? I do not know the Lord, nor will I let Israel go." So they said, "The God of the Hebrews has met with us. Please, let us go three days' journey into the desert and sacrifice to the Lord our God, lest He fall upon us with pestilence or with the sword."
- Ex. 15:22-27 ²² So Moses brought Israel from the Red Sea; then they went out into the Wilderness of Shur. And they went <u>three days</u> in the wilderness and found no water. ²³ Now when they came to Marah, they could not drink the waters of Marah, for they *were* <u>bitter</u>. Therefore the name of it was called [a]Marah. ²⁴ And the people complained against Moses, saying, "What shall we drink?" ²⁵ So he cried out to the Lord, and the Lord showed him a tree. When he cast *it* into the waters, the waters were made sweet.

 There He made a statute and an ordinance for them, and there He tested them, ²⁶ and said, "If you
- diligently heed the voice of the Lord your God and do what is right in His sight, give ear to His commandments and keep all His statutes, I will put none of the diseases on you which I have brought on the Egyptians. For I am the Lord who heals you."
- ²⁷ Then they came to Elim, where there *were* <u>twelve</u> wells of water and <u>seventy</u> palm trees; so they camped there by the waters.
- Ex. 16:1 And they journeyed from Elim, and all the congregation of the children of Israel came to the Wilderness of Sin....
- Num. 14:29 ²⁹ The carcasses of you who have complained against Me shall fall in this wilderness, all of you who were numbered, according to your entire number, from twenty years old and above.
- **Math. 4:1** Jesus was led by the Spirit into the Wilderness, tempted for 40 days (no one came to find him?)
- Rev. 17:3 ³ So he carried me away in the Spirit into the wilderness. And I saw a woman sitting on a scarlet beast *which was* full of names of blasphemy, having seven heads and ten horns. ⁴ The woman was arrayed in purple and scarlet, and adorned with gold and precious stones and pearls, having in her hand a golden cup full of abominations and the filthiness of ^[a]her fornication.
- Hosea 1:2 ² The beginning of the word of the Lord by Hosea. And the Lord said to Hosea, Go, take unto thee a wife of harlotry and children of harlotry: for the land hath committed great harlotry, departing from the Lord. Let's jump around in Hosea!
- Is. 32:16-19 ¹⁶ Then justice will dwell in the wilderness, And righteousness remain in the fruitful field. ¹⁷ The work of righteousness will be peace, And the effect of righteousness, quietness and assurance forever. ¹⁸ My people will dwell in a peaceful habitation, In secure

dwellings, and in quiet resting places, ¹⁹ Though hail comes down on the forest, And the **city** is brought low in humiliation.

Is. 35:3-8 ³ Strengthen the [a] weak hands, And make firm the [b] feeble knees. ⁴ Say to those *who are* fearful-hearted, "Be strong, do not fear! Behold, your God will come *with* vengeance, *With* the recompense of God; He will come and save you." ⁵ Then the eyes of the blind shall be opened, And the ears of the deaf shall be unstopped. ⁶ Then the lame shall leap like a deer, And the tongue of the dumb sing. For waters shall burst forth in the wilderness, And streams in the desert. ⁷ The parched ground shall become a pool, And the thirsty land springs of water; In the habitation of jackals, where each lay, *There shall be* grass with reeds and rushes. ⁸ A highway shall be there, and a road, And it shall be called the <u>Highway of Holiness</u>. The unclean shall not pass over it, But it *shall be* for others.

Whoever walks the road, although a fool, Shall not go astray.

Isaiah 40:1-9 1"Comfort, O comfort My people," says your God.

2"Speak kindly to Jerusalem; And call out to her, that her warfare has ended, That her iniquity has been removed, That she has received of the LORD'S hand Double for all her sins."

3A voice is calling, "Clear the way for the LORD in the wilderness; Make smooth in the desert a highway for our God. **4**"Let every valley be lifted up,

And every mountain and hill be made low;

And let the rough ground become a plain,

And the rugged terrain a broad valley;

5Then the glory of the LORD will be revealed,

And all flesh will see it together;

For the mouth of the LORD has spoken."

6A voice says, "Call out."

Then he answered, "What shall I call out?"

All flesh is grass, and all its loveliness is like the flower of the field.

7The grass withers, the flower fades,

When the breath of the LORD blows upon it;

9Get yourself up on a high mountain,

O Zion, bearer of good news,

Jeremiah ²⁵ "Behold, the days are coming," says the Lord, "that I will punish all *who are* circumcised with the uncircumcised—²⁶ Egypt, Judah, Edom, the people of Ammon, Moab, and all *who are* in the farthest corners, who dwell in the wilderness. For all *these* nations *are* uncircumcised, and all the house of Israel *are* uncircumcised in the heart."

Ezekiel 20:11-13 (Earthly Wilderness) changed scripture! Add Ezekiel 19 (Realm Wilderness)

- Ez. 6:14 ¹⁴ So I will stretch out My hand against them and make the land desolate, yes, more desolate than the wilderness toward Diblah, in all their dwelling places. Then they shall know that I *am* the Lord."
- Matt. 3:1-3 In those days John the Baptist came preaching in the wilderness of Judea, ² and saying, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand!" ³ For this is he who was spoken of by the prophet Isaiah, saying:
- "The voice of one crying in the wilderness:
- 'Prepare the way of the Lord;

Make His paths straight.'

- Hebrews 1:1-2 God, who at various times and in various ways spoke in time past to the fathers by the prophets, ² has in these last days spoken to us by *His* Son, whom He has appointed heir of all things, through whom also He made the <u>worlds</u>;
- Hebrews 3:16-19

 16 For who, having heard, rebelled? Indeed, was it not all who came out of Egypt, led by Moses? ¹⁷ Now with whom was He angry forty years? Was it not with those who sinned, whose corpses fell in the wilderness? ¹⁸ And to whom did He swear that they would not enter His rest, but to those who did not obey? ¹⁹ So we see that they could not enter in because of unbelief.
- II Esdra 1:18(before this it talks about Moses bringing them through the sea) "Saying, Why has thou brought us into this wilderness to kill us? It had been better for us to have served the Egyptians, than to die in this wilderness.
- Acts 7:38 This is the one who was in the congregation in the **wilderness** together with the angel who was speaking to him on Mount Sinai, and who was with our fathers; and he received living oracles to pass on to you.
- Psalm 72:9-10 Those who dwell in the **wilderness** will bow before Him, And His enemies will lick the dust ¹⁰ The kings of Tarshish and of the isles Will bring presents; The kings of Sheba and Seba Will offer gifts.
- Psalm 78:50-54 He made a path for His anger; He did not spare their soul from death, But gave their life over to the plague ⁵¹ And destroyed all the firstborn in Egypt, The first of *their* strength in the tents of Ham. ⁵² But He made His own people go forth like sheep, And guided them in the **wilderness** like a flock; ⁵³ And He led them on safely, so that they did not fear; But the sea overwhelmed their enemies. ⁵⁴ And He brought them to His holy border, This mountain *which* His right hand had acquired.
- Is. 21:1 The [a] burden against the Wilderness of the Sea. As whirlwinds in the South pass through, *So* it comes from the desert, from a terrible land. ² A distressing vision is declared to

me; The treacherous dealer deals treacherously, And the plunderer plunders. Go up, O Elam! Besiege, O Media! All its sighing I have made to cease.



Revelation 6. SEA/SHIPMASTER/ISLES

Zechariah 10:9-12 "When I scatter them among the peoples, They will remember Me in far countries,
And they with their children will live and come back.
"I will bring them back from the land of Egypt
And gather them from Assyria;
And I will bring them into the land of Gilead and Lebanon
Until no room can be found for them.
"And they will pass through the sea of distress
And He will strike the waves in the sea,
So that all the depths of the Nile will dry up;
And the pride of Assyria will be brought down
And the scepter of Egypt will depart.

Is. 27:1 In that day the LORD with his sore and great and strong sword shall punish leviathan the piercing serpent, even leviathan that crooked serpent; and he shall slay the dragon that is in the **sea**.

II Esdra 1:11-13 (talks about smiting Pharaoh before this scripture) All the nations have I destroyed before them, and in the east I have scattered the people of two provinces, even of Tyrus and Sidon, and have slain all their enemies. Speak thou therefore unto them, saying, Thus saith the Lord, I led you through the **sea** and in the beginning gave you a large and safe passage; I gave you Moses for a leader and Aaron for a priest.

Job 38:16-18 ¹⁶ "Have you entered the springs of the sea? Or have you walked in search of the depths? ¹⁷ Have the gates (gates of Hades/Death) of death been revealed to you? Or have you seen the **doors** of the shadow of death? That is this realm ¹⁸ Have you comprehended the breadth of the earth? Tell *Me*, if you know all this.

Ez. 27:3/27:26-27/28:8 you (Tyre) who are situated at the entrance of the sea/midst of the sea enriched the kings of the earth

Psalm 18:12-15 ¹² From the brightness before Him, His thick clouds passed with hailstones and coals of fire. ¹³ The Lord thundered from heaven, And the Most High uttered His voice, Hailstones and coals of fire. ¹⁴ He sent out His arrows and scattered the foe, Lightnings in abundance, and He vanquished them. ¹⁵ Then the channels of the sea were seen, the foundations of the world were uncovered at Your rebuke, O Lord, At the blast of the breath of Your nostrils.

Rev. 5:11-13 ¹¹ Then I looked, and I heard the voice of many angels around the throne, the living creatures, and the elders; and the number of them was ten thousand times ten thousand, and thousands of thousands, ¹² saying with a loud voice: "Worthy is the Lamb who was slain To receive power and riches and wisdom, And strength and honor and glory and blessing!"

- ¹³ And every creature which is <u>in heaven</u> and <u>on the earth</u> and <u>under the earth</u> and <u>such as are in the sea</u>, and all that are in them, I heard saying: "Blessing and honor and glory and power *Be* to Him who sits on the **throne**, And to the Lamb, forever and [a]ever!"
- Rev. 7:1-3 After these things I saw four angels standing at the four corners of the earth, holding the four winds of the earth, that the wind should not blow on the earth, on the sea, or on any tree. ² Then I saw another angel ascending from the east, having the seal of the living God. And he cried with a loud voice to the four angels to whom it was granted to harm the earth and the sea, ³ saying, "Do not harm the earth, the sea, or the trees till we have sealed the servants of our God on their foreheads."
- Rev 8:8 Then the second angel sounded: And *something* like a great mountain burning with fire was thrown into the sea, and a third of the sea became blood.
- Rev. 10:2 ² He had a little book open in his hand. And he set his right foot on the sea and *his* left *foot* on the land,
- Rev. 10:6 6 and swore by Him who lives forever and ever, who created heaven and the things that are in it, the earth and the things that are in it, and the sea and the things that are in it, that there should be delay no longer,
- Rev. 12:12 ¹² Therefore rejoice, O heavens, and you who dwell in them! Woe to the inhabitants of the earth and the sea! For the devil has come down to you, having great wrath, because he knows that he has a short time."
- Rev. 13:1 Then [a]I stood on the sand of the sea. And I saw a beast rising up out of the sea, having [b] seven heads and ten horns, and on his horns ten crowns, and on his heads a blasphemous name.
- Rev. 16:3 ³ Then the second angel poured out his bowl on the sea, and it became blood as of a dead *man*; and every living creature in the sea died.
- Rev. 18:17 ¹⁷ For in one hour such great riches [a]came to nothing.' Every shipmaster, all who travel by ship, sailors, and as many as trade on the sea, stood at a distance
- Rev. 18:19 ¹⁹ "They threw dust on their heads and cried out, weeping and wailing, and saying, 'Alas, alas, that great city, in which all who had ships on the sea became rich by her wealth! For in one hour she [a] is made desolate.'
- Rev. 18:21 ²¹ Then a mighty angel took up a stone like a great millstone and threw *it* into the sea, saying, "Thus with violence the great city Babylon shall be thrown down, and shall not be found anymore.

- Ez. 1:4 ⁴ Then I looked, and behold, a whirlwind was coming out of the north, a great cloud with raging fire engulfing itself; and brightness *was* all around it and radiating out of its midst like the color of amber, out of the midst of the fire.
- Ez. 27:3/27:26-27/28:8 you (**Tyre**) who are situated at the entrance of the sea/midst of the sea enriched the kings of the earth
- Ez. 30:3 For the day *is* near, Even the day of the Lord *is* near; It will be a day of clouds, the time of the Gentiles.
- Dan. 7:2 ² Daniel spoke, saying, "I saw in my vision by night, and behold, the four winds of heaven were stirring up the Great Sea.
- Psalm 74:13-14 'you divided the sea by Your might; you broke the heads of the sea monsters on the waters. You crushed the heads of Leviathan'
- Ez. 47:8 This water flows toward the eastern region, goes down into the valley, and enters the sea. When it reaches the sea, its waters are healed. And it shall be that every living thing that moves, where the **rivers** go, will live. There will be a very great multitude of fish, because these waters go there; for they will be healed and everything will live wherever the **river** goes.
- Ez. 27:15 ¹⁵ The men of Dedan *were* your traders; many isles *were* the market of your hand. They brought you ivory tusks and ebony as payment.
- Ez. 27:35 ³⁵ All the inhabitants of the isles will be astonished at you; Their kings will be greatly afraid, And *their* countenance will be troubled.
- II Esdra 7:3-13 and I said, speak on my Lord. Then said he unto me, the sea is set in a wide place that it might be deep and great. But put the case the entrance were narrow, and like a river; Who then could go into the sea to look upon it, and to rule it? If he went not through the narrow, how could he come in to the broad? There is also another thing; A city is built, and set upon a broad field, and is full of all good things: the entrance thereof is narrow and is set in a dangerous place to fall, like as if there were a fire on the right hand, and on the left a deep water: and one only path between them both, even between the fire and the water, so small that there could but one man go there at once. If this city now were given unto a man for an inheritance, if he never shall pass the danger set before it, how shall he receive this inheritance? And I said it is so Lord. Then said he unto me, Even so also is israel's portion. Because for their sakes I made the world: and when Adam transgressed my statutes, then was decreed that now is done. Then were the entrances of this world made narrow, full of sorrow and travail: they are but few and evil, full of

perils: and very painful period for the entrances of the elder world were wide and shore, and brought immortal fruit.

Job 26:6-14 Sheol *is* naked before Him, And Destruction has no covering. ⁷ He stretches out the north over empty space; *He* hangs the earth on nothing. ⁸ He binds up the water in His thick clouds, Yet the clouds ^[a] are not broken under it. ⁹ He covers the face of *His* throne, *And* spreads His cloud over it. ¹⁰ He drew a circular horizon on the face of the waters, At the boundary of light and darkness. ¹¹ The pillars of heaven tremble, And are ^[b] astonished at His rebuke. ¹² He stirs up the sea with His power, And by His understanding He breaks up ^[c] the storm. ¹³ By His Spirit He adorned the heavens; His hand pierced the fleeing serpent. ¹⁴ Indeed these *are* the mere edges of His ways, And how small a whisper we hear of Him! But the thunder of His power who can understand?"

Job 38:16-19 "Have you entered the springs of the sea? Or have you walked in search of the depths? ¹⁷ Have the gates of death been [a] revealed to you? Or have you seen the doors of the shadow of death? ¹⁸ Have you comprehended the breadth of the earth? Tell *Me*, if you know all this. ¹⁹ "Where *is* the way *to* the dwelling of light? And darkness, where *is* its place,

Psalm 8:5-9 For You have made him a little lower than [a]the angels, And You have crowned him with glory and honor. ⁶ You have made him to have dominion over the works of Your hands; You have put all *things* under his feet, ⁷ All sheep and oxen— Even the beasts of the field, ⁸ The birds of the air, And the fish of the sea That pass through the paths of the seas. ⁹ O Lord, our Lord, How excellent *is* Your name in all the earth!

Is. 23 Tyre, River, Sidon, Tarshish, sea

Is. 51:10-12 *Are* You not *the One* who dried up the sea, The waters of the great deep; That made the depths of the sea a road For the redeemed to cross over? ¹¹ So the ransomed of the Lord shall return, And come to Zion with singing, With everlasting joy on their heads. They shall obtain joy and gladness; Sorrow and sighing shall flee away. ¹² "I, *even* I, *am* He who comforts you. Who *are* you that you should be afraid Of a man *who* will die, And of the son of a man *who* will be made like grass?

Is. 63:11 Then he remembered the days of old, Moses *and* his people, *saying*: "Where *is* He who brought them up out of the sea With the [a]shepherd of His flock? Where *is* He who put His Ho II Esdra 4:6-8 Then answered I and said, what man is able to do that, that thou should ask such things of me? And he said unto me, if I should ask thee how great dwellings are in the midst of the sea, or how many springs are in the beginning of the deep, or how many springs are above the firmament, or which are the outgoings of paradise: pair adventure you would say unto me, I never went down into the deep, nor as yet into hell, neither did i ever climb up into heaven.



Revelation

7. DEAD/HADES (SHEOL) /PIT

Job 26:5-6 ⁵ "The dead tremble, Those under the **waters** and those inhabiting them. ⁶ Sheol *is* <u>naked</u> before Him, and destruction has <u>no covering</u>.

Jonah 2:2-9 ² And he said: "I cried out to the Lord because of my affliction, And He answered me. "Out of the belly of Sheol I cried,

And You heard my voice.

³ For You cast me into the deep,

Into the heart of the seas,

And the <u>floods</u> surrounded me; (remember that a flood comes after the people who are in the wilderness in Revelation)

All Your billows and Your waves passed over me.

⁴ Then I said, 'I have been cast out of Your sight;

Yet I will look again toward Your holy temple.'

⁵ The waters surrounded me, even to my soul;

The deep closed around me;

Weeds were wrapped around my head.

⁶ I went down to the [a]moorings of the mountains;

The earth with its **bars** *closed* behind me forever;

Yet You have brought up my life from the pit,

O Lord, my God.

7 "When my soul fainted within me,

I remembered the Lord;

And my prayer went *up* to You,

Into Your holy temple.

8 "Those who regard worthless idols

Forsake their own [b] Mercy.

⁹ But I will sacrifice to You

With the voice of thanksgiving;

I will pay what I have vowed.

Salvation *is* of the Lord." *Further proves that Jesus went to Sheol – it sounds like this was actually His prayer!)

Rev. 20:13 The **sea** gave up the dead who were in it and Death and Hades delivered up the dead who were in them. And they were judged, each one according to his works.

Is. 28 Therefore hear the word of the Lord, you scornful men, Who rule this people who *are* in Jerusalem, ¹⁵ Because you have said, "We have made a covenant with death, And with Sheol we are in agreement. When the overflowing scourge passes through, It will not come to us, For we have made lies our refuge, And under falsehood we have hidden ourselves."

Psalm 18:4-6 ⁴ The pangs of death surrounded me, And the floods of ungodliness made me afraid. ⁵ The sorrows of Sheol surrounded me; The snares of death confronted me. ⁶ In my distress I called upon the Lord, And cried out to my God; He heard my voice from His temple, And my cry came before Him, *even* to His ears

Is. 14:10-23 They all shall speak and say to you: 'Have you also become as weak as we? Have you become like us? 11 Your pomp is brought down to Sheol, And the sound of your stringed instruments; The maggot is spread under you, And worms cover you.' 12 "How you are fallen from heaven, O [a] Lucifer, son of the morning! How you are cut down to the ground, You who weakened the nations! ¹³ For you have said in your heart: 'I will ascend into heaven, I will exalt my throne above the stars of God; I will also sit on the mount of the congregation On the farthest sides of the north; ¹⁴I will ascend above the heights of the clouds, I will be like the Most High.' 15 Yet you shall be brought down to Sheol, To the lowest depths of the Pit. ¹⁶ "Those who see you will gaze at you, And consider you, saying: 'Is this the man who made the earth tremble, Who shook kingdoms, ¹⁷ Who made the world as a wilderness And destroyed its cities, Who [c]did not open the house of his prisoners?' 18"All the kings of the nations, All of them, sleep in glory, Everyone in his own house; ¹⁹ But you are cast out of your grave Like an dabominable branch, Like the garment of those who are slain, e Thrust through with a sword, Who go down to the stones of the pit, Like a corpse trodden underfoot. ²⁰ You will not be joined with them in burial, Because you have destroyed your land And slain your people. The brood of evildoers shall never be named. ²¹ Prepare slaughter for his children Because of the iniquity of their fathers, Lest they rise up and possess the land, And fill the face of the world with cities." ²² "For I will rise up against them," says the Lord of hosts, "And cut off from Babylon the name and remnant, And offspring and posterity," says the Lord. ²³ "I will also make it a possession for the porcupine, And marshes of muddy water; I will sweep it with the broom of destruction," says the Lord of hosts.

Is. 14:29-32 "Do not rejoice, all you of Philistia, Because the rod that struck you is broken; For out of the serpent's roots will come forth a viper, And its offspring will be a fiery flying serpent. ³⁰ The firstborn of the poor will feed, And the needy will lie down in safety; I will kill your roots with famine, And it will slay your remnant. ³¹ Wail, O gate! Cry, O city! All you of Philistia *are* dissolved; For smoke will come from the north, And no one will be alone in his [a] appointed times." ³² What will they answer the messengers of the nation? That the Lord has founded Zion, And the poor of His people shall take refuge in it.

Jonah 1:1-12 Now the word of the Lord came to Jonah the son of Amittai, saying, ² "Arise, go to Nineveh, that great city, and cry out against it; for their wickedness has come up before Me." ³ But Jonah arose to flee to **Tarshish** (Tyre) from the presence of the Lord. He went down to Joppa, and found a **ship** going to Tarshish; so he paid the fare, and went down into it, to go with them to Tarshish from the presence of the Lord. ⁴ But the Lord [a] sent out a great wind on the **sea**, and there was a mighty tempest on the sea, so that the **ship** was about to be broken up. ⁵ Then the mariners were afraid; and every man cried out to his god, and threw the <u>cargo</u> that *was* in the ship into the sea, to lighten [b] the load. But Jonah had gone down into the lowest parts of the ship, had lain down, and was fast asleep. ⁶ So the **captain** came to him, and said to him, "What do you mean, sleeper? Arise, call on your God; perhaps your God will consider us,

so that we may not perish." ⁷ And they said to one another, "Come, let us cast lots, that we may know for whose cause this trouble *has come* upon us." So they cast lots, and the lot fell on Jonah. ⁸ Then they said to him, "Please tell us! For whose cause *is* this trouble upon us? What is your occupation? And where do you come from? What is your country? And of what people are you?" ⁹ So he said to them, "I *am* a Hebrew; and I fear [c] the Lord, the God of heaven, who made the sea and the dry *land*." ¹⁰ Then the men were exceedingly afraid, and said to him, "Why have you done this?" For the men knew that he fled from the presence of the Lord, because he had told them. ¹¹ Then they said to him, "What shall we do to you that the sea may be calm for us?"—for the sea was growing more tempestuous. ¹² And he said to them, "Pick me up and [d] throw me into the sea; then the sea will become calm for you. For I know that this great tempest *is* because of me." *they throw him out into the "belly of the whale"

- Rev. 1:5 Grace to you and peace from Him who is and who was and who is to come, and from the seven Spirits who are before His throne, ⁵ and from Jesus Christ, the faithful witness, the firstborn from the dead, and the ruler over the kings of the earth.
- Rev. 1:18 ¹⁸ I *am* He who lives, and was dead, and behold, I am alive forevermore. Amen. And I have the keys of [a] Hades and of Death.
- Rev. 2:11 ¹¹ "He who has an ear, let him hear what the **Spirit says to the churches**. He who overcomes shall not be hurt by the second death."
- Rev. 3:1 "And to the [a] angel of the church in Sardis write, 'These things says He who has the seven Spirits of God and the seven stars: "I know your works, that you have a name that you are alive, but you are dead. ² Be watchful, and strengthen the things which remain, that are ready to die, for I have not found your works perfect before [b] God.
- Rev. 6:8 And I looked, and behold a pale horse: and his name that sat on him was **Death**, and **Hades** followed with him. And power was given unto them over the fourth part of the earth, to kill with **sword**, and with hunger, and with **death**, and with the **beasts of the earth**.
- Rev. 11:7 ⁷ When they finish their testimony, the beast that ascends out of the bottomless pit will make war against them, overcome them, and kill them.
- Rev. 11:18 after the 7th Trumpet sounds the time of the dead should be judged
- Rev. 14:13 Blessed are the dead (after speaking about the patience of the saints when Jesus and 144,000 are on Mt. Zion) who die in the Lord from now on that they may rest from their labors and their works follow them. *The dead in Christ shall rise 1st
- Rev. 20:20 I saw the dead, small and great, <u>standing</u> before God and books were opened (after 1,000 yr. reign)

- Rev. 20:5 But the rest of the dead did not live again until the **1,000 years were over**. This is the resurrection 20:6 Blessed and holy is he who has part in the 1st resurrection. Over the 2nd death has no power, but they shall be priests.
- Rev. 21:8 But the cowardly, [a] unbelieving, abominable, murderers, sexually immoral, sorcerers, idolaters, and all liars shall have their part in the lake which burns with fire and brimstone, which is the second death."
- Ez. 26:20 ²⁰ then I will bring you down with those who descend into the Pit, to the people of old, and I will make you dwell in the lowest part of the earth, in places desolate from antiquity, with those who go down to the Pit, so that you may never be inhabited; and I shall establish glory in the land of the living.
- Ez. 28:8 They shall throw you down into the Pit, And you shall die the death of the slain In the midst of the seas.
- Ez. 31:15 ¹⁵ "Thus says the Lord God: 'In the day when it went down to ^[a]hell, I caused mourning. I covered the deep because of it. I restrained its rivers, and the great waters were held back. I caused Lebanon to mourn for it, and all the trees of the field wilted because of it.
- Ez. 31:17 They also went down to hell with those slain by the sword... dwelt in the shadows among the nations
- Ez. 32:17 They also went down to hell with it, with those slain by the sword; and *those who were* its *strong* arm dwelt in its shadows among the nations.
- Ez. 32:24 ²⁴ "There *is* Elam and all her multitude,

All around her grave,

All of them slain, fallen by the sword,

Who have gone down uncircumcised to the lower parts of the earth,

Who caused their terror in the land of the living;

Now they bear their shame with those who go down to the Pit.

- Ez. 32:26 "There *are* Meshech and Tubal and all their multitudes, With all their graves around it, All of them uncircumcised, slain by the sword, Though they caused their terror in the land of the living.
- Matt. 11:22-24 ²² But I say to you, it will be more tolerable for Tyre and Sidon in the day of judgment than for you. ²³ And you, Capernaum, who^[a] are exalted to heaven, will be brought down to Hades; for if the mighty works which were done in you had been done in Sodom, it would have remained until this day. ²⁴ But I say to you that it shall be more tolerable for the land of Sodom in the day of judgment than for you."

Matt. 10:22-28²⁷ "Whatever I tell you in the dark, speak in the light; and what you hear in the ear, preach on the housetops.²⁸ And do not fear those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul. But rather fear Him who is able to destroy both soul and body in hell. ²⁹ Are not two sparrows sold for a ^[c]copper coin? And not one of them falls to the ground apart from your Father's will. ³⁰ But the very hairs of your head are all numbered.

Acts 2:17-28 ¹⁷ And it shall come to pass in the last days, saith God, I will pour out of my Spirit upon all flesh: and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams: ¹⁸ And on my servants and on my handmaidens I will pour out in those days of my Spirit; and they shall prophesy: ¹⁹ And I will shew wonders in heaven above, and signs in the earth beneath; blood, and fire, and vapour of smoke: ²⁰ The sun shall be turned into darkness, and the moon into blood, before the great and notable day of the Lord come: ²¹ And it shall come to pass, that whosoever shall call on the name of the Lord shall be saved. ²² Ye men of Israel, hear these words; Jesus of Nazareth, a man approved of God among you by miracles and wonders and signs, which God did by him in the midst of you, as ye yourselves also know: ²³ Him, being delivered by the determinate counsel and foreknowledge of God, ye have taken, and by wicked hands have crucified and slain: ²⁴ Whom God hath raised up, having loosed the pains of death: because it was not possible that he should be holden of it. ²⁵ For David speaketh concerning him, I foresaw the Lord always before my face, for he is on my right hand, that I should not be moved: ²⁶ Therefore did my heart rejoice, and my tongue was glad; moreover also my flesh shall rest in hope ²⁷ Because thou wilt not leave my soul in hell, neither wilt thou suffer thine Holy One to see corruption. ²⁸ Thou hast made known to me the ways of life; thou shalt make me full of joy with thy countenance. ²⁹ Men and brethren, let me freely speak unto you of the patriarch David, that he is both dead and buried, and his sepulchre is with us unto this day. ³⁰ Therefore being a prophet, and knowing that God had sworn with an oath to him, that of the fruit of his loins, according to the flesh, he would raise up Christ to sit on his throne; ³¹ He seeing this before spake of the resurrection of Christ, that his soul was not left in hell, neither his flesh did see corruption. ³² This Jesus hath God raised up, whereof we all are witnesses. 33 Therefore being by the right hand of God exalted, and having received of the Father the promise of the Holy Ghost, he hath shed forth this, which ye now see and hear. ³⁴ For David is not ascended into the heavens: but he saith himself. The Lord said unto my Lord. Sit thou on my right hand, ³⁵ Until I make thy foes thy footstool. ³⁶ Therefore let all the house of Israel know assuredly, that God hath made the same Jesus, whom ye have crucified, both Lord and Christ. ³⁷ Now when they heard this, they were pricked in their heart, and said unto Peter and to the rest of the apostles, Men and brethren, what shall we do? ³⁸ Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.

1 Corin. $15:52^{52}$ in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised <u>incorruptible</u>, and we shall be changed.

Hebrews 2:14-15 ¹⁴ Inasmuch then as the children have partaken of flesh and blood, He Himself likewise shared in the same, that through death He might destroy him who had the power of death, that is, the devil, ¹⁵ and release those who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage.

1 Peter 3:18-20 James, a bondservant of God and of the Lord Jesus Christ, To the twelve tribes which are scattered abroad: Greetings. ² My brethren, count it all joy when you fall into various trials,

1 Peter 4:4-6 ⁴ In regard to these, they think it strange that you do not run with *them* in the same flood of dissipation, speaking evil of you. ⁵ They will give an account to Him who is ready to judge the living and the dead. ⁶ For this reason the gospel was preached also to those who are dead, that they might be judged according to men in the flesh, but live according to God in the spirit.

Then the fifth angel sounded: And I saw a star fallen from heaven to the earth. To Rev. 9:1-12 him was given the key to the bottomless pit. ² And he opened the bottomless pit, and smoke arose out of the pit like the smoke of a great furnace. So the sun and the air were darkened because of the smoke of the pit. ³ Then out of the smoke **locusts** came upon the earth. And to them was given power, as the **scorpions** of the earth have power. ⁴ They were commanded not to harm the grass of the earth, or any green thing, or any tree, but only those men who do not have the seal of God on their foreheads. ⁵ And [b] they were not given *authority* to kill them, but to torment them for five months. Their torment was like the torment of a scorpion when it strikes a man. ⁶ In those days men will seek death and will not find it; they will desire to die, and death will flee from them. ⁷ The shape of the **locusts** was like horses prepared for battle. On their heads were crowns of something like gold, and their faces were like the faces of men. 8 They had hair like women's hair, and their teeth were like **lions'** teeth. ⁹ And they had breastplates like breastplates of iron, and the sound of their wings was like the sound of chariots with many horses running into battle. ¹⁰ They had tails like scorpions, and there were stings in their tails. Their power was to hurt men five months. 11 And they had as king over them the angel of the bottomless pit, whose name in Hebrew is [c] Abaddon, but in Greek he has the name [d] Apollyon.

¹² One woe is past. Behold, still two more woes are coming after these things.

For by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, Colossians 1:16-19 visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers. All things were created through Him and for Him. And He is before all things, and in Him all things consist. And He is the head of the body, the church, who is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, that in all things He may have the preeminence. For it pleased the Father that in Him all the fullness should dwell.



Revelation 8. EGYPT/SODOM

Ezekiel 32:2-32 ² Son of man, take up a lamentation for Pharaoh king of Egypt king is a key word that is not the Pharaoh of Genesis and say unto him, Thou art like a young lion of the nations, and thou art as a whale/monster in the seas and thou came forth with thy rivers, and troubled the waters with thy feet, and fouling their rivers.³ Thus saith the Lord God; I will therefore spread out my net over thee with a company of many people; and they shall bring thee up in my net.⁴ Then will I leave thee upon the land, I will cast thee forth upon the open field, and will cause all the birds of the heaven to remain upon thee, and I will fill the beasts of the whole earth with thee.⁵

Rev. 11:8 And their dead bodies will lie in the street of the great city which spiritually is called Sodom and **Egypt**, where also our Lord was crucified. The key words are "**spiritually** called Sodom and Egypt".

Is. 11:15-16 Septuagint 15 And the Lord shall make desolate the sea of Egypt; and he shall lay his hand on the river with a strong wind, and he shall smite the seven channels, so that men shall pass through it dry-shod. 16 And there shall be a passage for my people that is left in Egypt: and it shall be to Israel as the day when he came forth out of the land of Egypt.

Is. 19:1-5 The burden^[a] against Egypt. Behold, the Lord rides on a swift cloud, And will come into Egypt; The idols of Egypt will totter at His presence, And the heart of Egypt will melt in its midst. ² "I will set Egyptians against Egyptians; Everyone will fight against his brother, And everyone against his neighbor, city against city, kingdom against kingdom. ³ The spirit of Egypt will fail in its midst; I will destroy their counsel, And they will consult the idols and the charmers, The mediums and the sorcerers. ⁴ And the Egyptians I will give Into the hand of a cruel master, And a fierce king will rule over them," Says the Lord, the Lord of hosts. ⁵ The waters will fail from the sea, And the river will be wasted and dried up.

Is. 19:19-25 ¹⁹ In that day there will be an altar to the Lord in the midst of the land of Egypt, and a pillar to the Lord at its border. ²⁰ And it will be for a sign and for a witness to the Lord of hosts in the land of Egypt; for they will cry to the Lord because of the oppressors, and He will send them a Savior and a Mighty One, and He will deliver them. ²¹ Then the Lord will be known to Egypt, and the Egyptians will know the Lord in that day, and will make sacrifice and offering; yes, they will make a vow to the Lord and perform *it.* ²² And the Lord will strike Egypt, He will strike and heal *it;* they will return to the Lord, and He will be entreated by them and heal them. ²³ In that day there will be a highway from **Egypt to Assyria**, and the Assyrian will come into Egypt and the Egyptian into Assyria, and the Egyptians will serve with the Assyrians. ²⁴ In that day Israel will be one of three with Egypt and Assyria—a blessing in the midst of the land, ²⁵ whom the Lord of hosts shall bless, saying, "Blessed *is* Egypt My people, and Assyria the work of My hands, and Israel My inheritance."

- **1 Maccabees 1:1-16** And there came out of them a wicked root Antiochus surnamed Epiphanes, son of Antiochus the king, who had been an hostage at Rome, and he reigned in the hundred and thirty and seventh year of the kingdom of the Greeks.
- 11 In those days went there out of Israel wicked men, who persuaded many, saying, Let us go and make a covenant with the heathen that are round about us: for since we departed from them we have had much sorrow. 12 So this device pleased them well. 13 Then certain of the people were so forward herein, that they went to the king, who gave them license to do after the ordinances of the heathen: 14 Whereupon they built a place of exercise at Jerusalem according to the customs of the heathen: 15 And made themselves uncircumcised, and forsook the holy covenant, and joined themselves to the heathen, and were sold to do mischief.
- 16 Now when the kingdom was established before Antiochus, he thought to reign over Egypt that he might have the dominion of two realms.
- Is. 3:9 The look on their countenance witnesses against them. And they declare their sin as Sodom; they do not hide it. Woe to their soul! For they have brought evil upon themselves.



Revelation

9. PRESENCE OF THE LORD/BACK

Gen. 4:16 Then Cain went out from the presence of the Lord and dwelt in the land of Nod on the east of Eden.

Is. 39:22-23 So the House of Israel shall know that I am the LORD their God from that day forward. The Gentiles shall know that the House of Israel went into captivity for their iniquity; because they were unfaithful to Me, therefore, **I hid My face from them**.

Psalm 80:10-11 The mountains were covered with its shadow, And the cedars of God with its boughs. It was sending out its branches to the sea and its shoots to the River. Why have You broken down its hedges, so that all who pass *that* way pick its *fruit?* A boar from the forest eats it away and whatever moves in the field feeds on it. O God *of* hosts, turn again now, we beseech You; Look down from heaven and see, and take care of this vine, even the shoot which Your right hand has planted, and on the son whom You have strengthened for Yourself. Revelation

10. CORNERS OF THE EARTH/4 WINDS/UNDER THE EARTH = THIS REALM

- **Rev. 7:1** After these things I saw four angels standing at the **four corners** of the earth, holding the **four winds of the earth**, that the wind should not blow on the **earth**, on the **sea**, or on any **tree**.......... v3 saying, "Do not harm the earth, the sea or the trees till we have sealed the servants of our God on their foreheads."
- Mat. 24:31 And He will send His angels, with a great sound of a trumpet, and they will gather together His elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other.
- Ez. 37:1-9 The hand of the LORD was upon me, and He brought me out by the Spirit of the LORD and set me down in the middle of the valley; and it was full of bones. 2He caused me to pass among them round about, and behold, there were very many on the surface of the valley; and lo, they were very dry. 3He said to me, "Son of man, can these bones live?" And I answered, "O Lord GOD, You know." 4Again He said to me, "Prophesy over these bones and say to them, 'O dry bones, hear the word of the LORD.' 5"Thus says the Lord GOD to these bones, 'Behold, I will cause breath to enter you that you may come to life. 6'I will put sinews on you, make flesh grow back on you, cover you with skin and put breath in you that you may come alive; and you will know that I am the LORD."

7So I prophesied as I was commanded; and as I prophesied, there was a noise, and behold, a rattling; and the bones came together, bone to its bone. 8And I looked, and behold, sinews were on them, and flesh grew and skin covered them; but there was no breath in them. 9Then He said to me, "Prophesy to the breath, prophesy, son of man, and say to the breath, 'Thus says the Lord GOD, "Come from the four winds, O breath, and breathe on these slain, that they come to life."" 10So I prophesied as He commanded me, and the breath came into them, and they came to life and stood on their feet, an exceedingly great army.

- **Is. 11:12** He will set up a banner for the nations, And will assemble the outcasts of Israel, And gather together the dispersed of Judah from the **four corners** of the earth v15 and make men cross over dryshod. V16 There will be a highway for the remnant of His people who will be left from Assyria, as it was for Israel in the day that he came up from the land of Egypt.
- Rev. 20:8 and will go out to deceive the nations which are in the **four corners** of the earth, Gog and Magog, to gather them together to battle, whose number *is* as the sand of the sea. This is after the 1000 year reign, Satan is released to deceive this realm and then gather the nations for Armageddon (6th Bowl right before the end of time)
- Dan. 7:2-4 Daniel said, "I was looking in my vision by night, and behold, the **four winds** of heaven were stirring up the great sea. **3**"And four great beasts were coming up from the sea, different from one another.
- Mk. 13:27 And then He will send His angels, and **gather together** His **elect** from the **four winds**, from the farthest part of earth to the farthest part of heaven.



Revelation 11. MOUNTAIN

Isaiah 2:2-4 ² And it shall come to pass in the last days that is a key word, that the mountain of the Lord's house shall be established in the top of the mountains, and shall be exalted above the hills; and all nations shall flow unto it. ³ And many people shall go and say, Come ye, and let us go up to the mountain of the Lord, to the house of the God of Jacob; and he will teach us of his ways, and we will walk in his paths: for out of Zion shall go forth the law, and the word of the Lord from Jerusalem. ⁴ And he shall judge among the nations, and shall rebuke many people: and they shall beat their swords into plowshares, and their spears into pruninghooks: nation shall not lift up sword against nation, neither shall they learn war anymore.

- **Rev. 17:9** "Here *is* the mind which has wisdom: The seven heads are seven **mountains** on which the woman sits. I believe Hades "sits" or reigns over this realm, these seven continents.
- Rev. 8:8 Then the second angel sounded: And *something* like a great mountain burning with fire was thrown into the sea, and a third of the sea became blood.
- Dan. 2:32 Stone strikes the iron and clay and breaks it and I were crushed v35 and the wind carried them away so that no trace was found and the stone that struck the image became a great mountain and filled the
- Math. 4:5 in the **wilderness** was taken to a high mountain and showed all the kingdoms of the world, "all this power I will give thee and the glory of them for that is delivered unto me, and to whomsoever I will give it"
- Rev. 16:20 Then every island fled away and the mountains were not found (after the 7th bowl)
- Rev. 21:10 ¹⁰ And he carried me away in the Spirit to a great and high mountain, and showed me the great city, the holy Jerusalem, descending out of heaven from God,
- Ez. 6:2-3 Septuagint 2Son of man, set thy face against the mountains of Israel, and prophesy against them; 3and thou shalt say, Ye mountains of Israel, hear the word of the Lord; thus saith the Lord to the mountains, and to the hills, and to the valleys, and to the forests; Behold, I bring a sword upon you, and your high places shall be utterly destroyed.
- Ez. 18:6 Septuagint 5But the man who shall be just, who executes judgment and righteousness, 6who shall not eat upon the mountains, and shall not at all lift up his eyes to the devices of the house of Israel, and shall not defile his neighbor's wife, and shall not draw nigh to her that is removed, 7and shall not oppress any man, but shall return the pledge of the debtor, and shall be guilty of no plunder, shall give his bread to the hungry, and clothe the naked; 8and shall not lend his money upon usury, and shall not receive usurious increase, and shall turn back his hand from injustice, shall execute righteous judgment between a man and his neighbor, 9and

Revelation 12. NATIONS/WORLD

Deut. 32:8 When the Most High divided the **nations**, when he separated the sons of Adam, he set the bounds of the **nations** according to the number of the angels of GOD. And His people Jacob because the portion of the LORD, Israel was the line of his inheritance. He maintained him in the wilderness, in burning thirst and a dry land: he led him about and instructed him, and kept him as the apple of His eye. As an eagle would watch over his brood, and yearns over his young, receives them having spread his wings and take them up on his back: the LORD alone led them, there was no strange god with them. Septuagint

Rev. 20:12 ²⁴ And the **nations** of those who are saved shall walk in its light, and the kings of the earth bring their glory and honor into it.

Ez. 32:19:17- "Son of man, wail over the multitude of Egypt, and cast them down to the depths of the earth, Her and the daughters of the **famous nations**, with those who go down to the Pit: Whom do you surpass in beauty? Go down, be placed with the uncircumcised. They shall fall in the midst of those slain by the **sword**; She is delivered to the sword, drawing her and all her multitudes. The strong among the mighty shall speak to him out of the midst of hell. V22 Assyria is there, and all her company. V26 Meshech and Tubal and all their multitudes, with all their graves around it.....slain by the sword..... who have gone down to hell with their weapons of war. V29 there is Edom...down to the Pit. V30 princesses of the north

Gen. 10:15-15 The sons of Japhet, Gomer, and Magog, and Madoi, and Jovan and Elisa and Tubel and Meshech and Thiras. The sons of Gomer were Ashkenaz, Riphath and Toarmah. The sons of Javan were Elishahm Tarshish, Kittim and Dodanim. From these the coastland peoples of the Gentiles were separated into their lands, everyone according to his language, according to their families, into their nations. The Gentiles are this realm, and the nations are the other realm, but the Gentiles are a people, who also live inside places called nations or countries.

II Esdra 7:2-27 When I had finished speaking these words, the angel who had been sent to me on the former nights was sent to me again. 2 He said to me, "Rise, Ezra, and listen to the words that I have come to speak to you." 3 I said, "Speak, my lord." And he said to me, "There is a sea set in a wide expanse so that it is deep and vast, 4 but it has an entrance set in a narrow place, so that it is like a river. 5 If there are those who wish to reach the sea, to look at it or to navigate it, how can they come to the broad part unless they pass through the narrow part? 6 Another example: There is a city built and set on a plain, and it is full of all good things; 7 but the entrance to it is narrow and set in a precipitous place, so that there is fire on the right hand and deep water on the left. 8 There is only one path lying between them, that is, between the fire and the water, so that only one person can walk on the path. 9 If now the city is given to someone as an inheritance, how will the heir receive the inheritance unless by passing through the appointed danger?" 10 I said, "That is right, lord." He said to me, "So also is Israel's portion. 11 For I made the world for their sake, and when Adam transgressed my statutes, what had been made was judged. 12 And so the entrances of

this world were made narrow and sorrowful and toilsome; they are few and evil, full of dangers and involved in great hardships. 13 But the entrances of the greater world are broad and safe, and yield the fruit of immortality. 14 Therefore unless the living pass through the difficult and futile experiences, they can never receive those things that have been reserved for them. 15 Now therefore why are you disturbed, seeing that you are to perish? Why are you moved, seeing that you are mortal? 16 Why have you not considered in your mind what is to come, rather than what is now present?" 17 Then I answered and said, "O sovereign Lord, you have ordained in your law that the righteous shall inherit these things, but that the ungodly shall perish. 18 The righteous, therefore, can endure difficult circumstances while hoping for easier ones; but those who have done wickedly have suffered the difficult circumstances and will never see the easier ones." 19 He said to me, "You are not a better judge than the Lord, or wiser than the Most High! 20 Let many perish who are now living, rather than that the law of God that is set before them be disregarded! 21 For the Lord strictly commanded those who came into the world, when they came, what they should do to live, and what they should observe to avoid punishment. 22 Nevertheless they were not obedient, and spoke against him; they devised for themselves vain thoughts, 23 and proposed to themselves wicked frauds; they even declared that the Most High does not exist, and they ignored his ways. 24 They scorned his law, and denied his covenants; they have been unfaithful to his statutes, and have not performed his works. 25 That is the reason, Ezra, that empty things are for the empty, and full things are for the full. 26 "For indeed the time will come, when the signs that I have foretold to you will come to pass, that the city that now is not seen shall appear, and the land that now is hidden shall be disclosed. 27 Everyone who has been delivered from the evils that I have foretold shall see my wonders. 28 For my son the Messiah shall be revealed with those who are with him This is speaking about the Millennial Reign - which we are going to get to as well. Go down to the bottom to the nations

And the sons of Ham were Cush, Mizraim, Put, and Canaan. The sons of Cush were Seba, Havila, Sabtah, Raamah, and Sabtechanah; and the sons of Raamah were Sheba and Deban. Cush begot Nimrod. He began to be a giant upon the earth He was a giant hunter before the LORD GOD; therefore they say, As Nimrod the giant hunter before the LORD. And the beginning of his kingdom was Babylon, and Orech and Archad and Chlanne, in the land of Senaar. Out of that land came Asshur (Assyria) and built Nineveh. And to Canaan begot Sidon his first born, and the Chettite, and the Jubusite and the Amorite and the Girgashite, and the Evite, and the Arukite and the Aseniteand the Aradian and the Samarean and the Amathite and after this the tribes of the Chananites were dispersed. And the boundaries of the Chananites were from Sidon till one come to Gerara and Gaza, till one comes to Sodom and Gormorrha, Adama and Seboim, as far as Dasa. These were the sons of Ham in their tribes, according to their tongues, in their countries and in their nations. 9Thou shalt rule them with a rod of iron; thou shalt dash them in pieces as a potter's vessel.

Is. 11:1-3 There shall come forth a **Rod** from the **stem** of Jesse (King David is his son) And a **Branch** shall grow out of his **roots**. 2 The Spirit of the Lord shall rest upon Him, The Spirit of wisdom and understanding, The Spirit of counsel and might, The Spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the Lord.

Ez. 25-29 and chapter 27 they shall lament for her, even for Egypt, and for all her multitude, saith the Lord God.¹⁷ It came to pass also in the twelfth year, in the fifteenth day of the month, that the word of the Lord came unto me, saying, ¹⁸ Son of man, wail for the multitude of Egypt (1), and cast them down, even her, and the daughters of the famous nations unto the depths of the earth, with them that go down into the pit. 19 Whom do you surpass in beauty? go down, and be thou laid with the uncircumcised.²⁰ They shall fall in the midst of them that are slain by the **sword**: she is delivered to the sword: draw her and all her multitudes.²¹ The strong among the mighty shall speak to him out of the midst of hell with them that help him: they are gone down, they lie uncircumcised, slain by the sword.²² Assyria (2) is there and all her company: his graves are about him: all of them slain, fallen by the sword:²³ Whose graves are set in the sides of the pit, and her company is round about her grave: all of them slain, fallen by the sword, which caused terror in the land of the living.²⁴ There is Elam (3) and all her multitude round about her grave, all of them slain, fallen by the sword, which are gone down uncircumcised into the depths of the earth, which caused their terror in the land of the living; yet have they borne their shame with them that go down to the pit. 25 They have set her a bed in the midst of the slain with all her multitude: her graves are round about him: all of them uncircumcised, slain by the sword: though their terror was caused in the <u>land of the living</u>, yet have they borne their shame with them that go down to the pit: he is put in the midst of them that be slain.²⁶ There is **Meshech**, **Tubal**, (4/5) and all her multitude: her graves are round about him: all of them uncircumcised, slain by the **sword**, though they caused their terror in the land of the living.²⁷ And they shall not lie with the mighty that are fallen of the uncircumcised, which are gone down to hell with their weapons of war: and they have laid their swords under their heads, but their iniquities shall be upon their bones, though they were the terror of the mighty in the land of the living. ²⁸ Yea, thou shalt be broken in the midst of the uncircumcised, and shalt lie with them that are slain with the sword.²⁹ There is Edom, (6) her kings, and all her princes, which with their might are laid by them that were slain by the **sword**: they shall lie with the uncircumcised, and with them that go

down to the pit.³⁰ There be the princes of the **north**, all of them, and all the **Sidonians**, (7) which are gone down with the slain; with their terror they are ashamed of their might; and they lie uncircumcised with them that be slain by the sword, and bear their shame with them that go down to the pit.³¹ **Pharaoh** (Satan) shall see them, and shall be comforted over all his multitude, even Pharaoh and **all his army slain by the sword**, saith the Lord God.³² For I have caused my terror in the land of the living: and he shall be laid in the midst of the uncircumcised with them that are slain with the sword, even Pharaoh and all his multitude, saith the Lord God.

how could he come in to the broad? There is also another thing; A city is built, and set upon a broad field, and is full of all good things: the entrance thereof is narrow and is set in a dangerous place to fall, like as if there were a fire on the right hand, and on the left a deep water: and one only path between them both, even between the fire and the water, so small that there could but one man go there at once. II Esdra 8:50-56 for many great miseries shall be done to them that in the latter times shall dwell in the world, because they have walked in great pride. But understand for thyself, and seek out the glory for such as be like thee. For unto you is paradise opened, the tree of life is planted, the time to come is prepared, plenteousness is made ready, the city is built, and rest is allowed, yay, perfect goodness and wisdom. She is broken who was the **gateway** of the peoples; now she is turned over to me; I shall be filled; she is laid waste.' ³ "Therefore thus says the Lord God: 'Behold, I am against you, O Tyre, and will cause many nations to come up against you, as the sea causes its waves to come up. ⁴ And they shall destroy the walls of Tyre and break down her towers; I will also scrape her dust from her, and make her like the top of a rock. ⁵ It shall be a place for spreading nets in the midst of the sea, for I have spoken,' says the Lord God; 'it shall become plunder for the nations. ⁶ Also her daughter villages which are in the fields shall be slain by the sword. Neither do I rear young men,

Nor bring up virgins."

⁵ When the report reaches **Egypt**,

They also will be in agony at the report of Tyre.

⁶ Cross over to Tarshish;

Wail, you inhabitants of the coastland!

⁷ Is this your joyous city,

Whose antiquity is from ancient days,

Whose feet carried her far off to dwell?

⁸ Who has taken this counsel against Tyre, the crowning *city*,

Whose merchants are princes,

Whose **traders** *are* the honorable of the earth?

Septuagint: Who has devised this counsel against Tyre? Is she inferior? Or has she no strength? Her merchants were the glorious princes of the earth.

⁹ The Lord of hosts has purposed it,

To bring to dishonor the pride of all glory,

To bring into contempt all the honorable of the earth.

¹⁰ Overflow through your land like the River,

O daughter of Tarshish;

There is no more ^[g]strength.

¹¹ He stretched out His hand over the **sea**,

He shook the kingdoms;

The Lord has given a commandment against Canaan

To destroy its strongholds.

¹² And He said, "You will rejoice no more,

O you oppressed virgin daughter of Sidon.

Arise, cross over to Cyprus;

There also you will have no rest."

¹³ Behold, the land of the Chaldeans,

Assyria founded it for wild beasts of the desert.

You forgotten harlot;

Make sweet melody, sing many songs,

That you may be remembered."

¹⁷ And it shall be, at the end of seventy years, that the Lord will deal with Tyre (at the end of 70 years Israel was allowed to return to Jerusalem from Babylon in this realm). She will return to her hire, and commit fornication with all the kingdoms of the world on the face of the earth. ¹⁸ Her gain and her pay will be set apart for the Lord; it will not be treasured nor laid up, for her gain will be for those who dwell before the Lord, to eat sufficiently, and for ^[h] fine clothing.

Ez. 28:12-19 "You were the seal of perfection,

Full of wisdom and perfect in beauty.

¹³ You were in Eden, the garden of God;

Every precious stone was your covering:

The sardius, topaz, and diamond,

Beryl, onyx, and jasper,

Sapphire, turquoise, and emerald with gold.

The workmanship of your timbrels and pipes

Was prepared for you on the day you were created.

¹⁴ "You were the anointed cherub who covers;

I established you;

You were on the holy mountain of God;

You walked back and forth in the midst of fiery stones.

II Esdra 1:10-11 Many kings have I destroyed for their sakes; Pharaoh with his servants and all his power have I smitten down. All the nations have I destroyed before them and in the east I have scattered the people of two provinces, even of Tyrus and Sidon and have slain all their enemies. (people of the east are this realm – goes on to talk about leading the people through the sea by Moses!)

Neh. 13:16 Men of Tyre dwelt there also, who brought in fish and all kinds of goods and sold them on the Sabbath to the children of Judah and in Jerusalem.

15. GENTILES

Psalm 105:44-45

44 He gave them the lands of the [a]Gentiles, And they inherited the labor of the nations,

45 That they might observe His statutes

And keep His laws.

Isaiah 60:16-22 Septuagint And thou shalt suck the milk **of the Gentiles**, and shalt eat the wealth of kings: and shalt know that I am the Lord that saves thee and delivers thee, the Holy One of Israel.

Josh. 1:1-9 After the death of Moses the servant of the Lord, it came to pass that the Lord spoke to Joshua the son of Nun, Moses' assistant, saying: ² "Moses My servant is dead. Now therefore, arise, go over this Jordan, you and all this people, to the land which I am giving to them—the children of Israel. ³ Every place that the sole of your foot will tread upon I have given you, as I said to Moses. ⁴ From the wilderness and this Lebanon as far as the great river, the River Euphrates, all the land of the Hittites, (I think this means nations!) and to the Great Sea toward the going down of the sun, shall be your territory. ⁵ No man shall be able to stand before you all the days of your life; as I was with Moses, so I will be with you. I will not leave you nor forsake you. ⁶Be strong and of good courage, for to this people you shall [a] divide as an inheritance the land which I swore to their fathers to give them. ⁷Only be strong and very courageous, that you may observe to do according to all the law which Moses My servant commanded you; do not turn from it to the right hand or to the left, that you may [b] prosper wherever you go. ⁸ This **Book of the Law** shall not depart from your mouth, but you^[c] shall meditate in it day and night, that you may observe to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success. ⁹ Have I not commanded you? Be strong and of good courage; do not be afraid, nor be dismayed, for the Lord your God is with you wherever you go."

Ez. 31:2 'Whom are you like in your greatness? Indeed Assyria was a <u>cedar in Lebanon</u>, with fine branches that shaded the forest, and of high stature.... and sent out rivulets to all the trees of the field. V8 The cedars in the garden of God could not hide it....v9 so that all the trees of Eden envied it, That were in the garden of God. V12... all the peoples of the earth have gone from under its shadow and left it. V13 On its ruin will remain all the birds of the heavens, And all the **beast of the field** will come to its branches. V14 So that no **trees** by the waters may ever again exalt themselves for their height, nor set their tops among the thick boughs, that no tree which drinks water may ever be big enough to reach up to them. For they have all been delivered to death, to the depths of the earth, Among the children of men who go down to the Pit. V15 'Thus says the Lord God: 'In the day when it went down to hell, I caused mourning. I covered the deep because of it. I restrained its rivers, and the great waters were held back. I caused Lebanon to mourn for it, and all the trees of the field wilted because of it. V16 I made the nations shake at the sound of its fall, when I cast it down to hell together with those who descend into the Pit; and all the trees of Eden, the choice and best of Lebanon....they all went down to **hell** with it, those who slain by the **sword**.... this is Pharaoh.
