_____. God is consistent in His judgments, He is a God of order and consistency because we can then get to know how God works. Remember that – because this world (realm), will continually try to get us to follow its ways instead of the ways of God’s Kingdom (realm)! Our ultimate goal is to go back to where?

_____ So let’s dive into this!

2. Scriptures tell us that Paul, knowing what he knew, cried for the future of the ecclesia because the deception was already starting at his place in time! Acts 20:29-31 ”For I know this, that after my departure savage wolves will come in among you, not sparing the flock. Also, from among yourselves men will rise up, speaking perverse things, to draw away the disciples after themselves. Therefore watch and remember that for three years I did not cease to warn everyone night and day with tears.”

_____. We are also going to learn when we study the Book of Revelation, great trees such as the cedar, fir, etc. can be angels! Some have great branches (or authority) and others are created differently – but for now, just know that trees can represent angels.

7. This is why the Bible says, you will know a person by their

_____. Matthew 7:16-20

“By their fruit you will recognize them. Do people pick grapes from thornbushes, or figs from thistles? Likewise, every good tree bears good fruit, but a bad tree bears bad fruit. A good tree cannot bear bad fruit, and a bad tree cannot bear good fruit. Every tree that does not bear good fruit is cut down and thrown into the fire. Thus, by their fruit you will know them.” Let’s look at Colossians 1:9 “.....and to ask that you may be filled with the knowledge of His will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding; 10that you may walk worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing Him, being fruitful in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God;” Romans 6:20-22 For when you were slaves of sin, you were free in regard to righteousness. What fruit did you have then in the things of which you are now ashamed? For the end of those things is death. But now having been set free from sin, and having become slaves of God you have your fruit to holiness, and the end, everlasting life.”

Woe unto them that call evil good, and good evil; that put darkness for light, and light for darkness; that put bitter for sweet, and sweet for bitter. Isaiah 5:20

Let's look at what eating really means in scriptures. First of all, the scriptures never use the word apple. And remember, the Old Covenant or Testament, uses physical examples and then Jesus in the New Covenant or Testament, takes them and shows us what they really mean in the spiritual realm. Let's look at examples of "eating" and what it means. When Jesus fasted and Satan came to Him to try and tempt Him (here we see Satan trying to tempt through "food" again by telling Jesus to turn the stones into bread), Jesus tells him, "Man does not live by bread alone, but by every word that comes from the mouth of God" (Matthew 4:4,

"The Bible often speaks of the spiritual food we need: God's Word provides milk (1 Peter 2:2); it is meat (1 Corinthians 3:2) and bread (Deuteronomy 8:3; Job 23:12); and it is sweeter than honey (Psalm 119:103). The prophet Jeremiah wrote, "When your words came, I ate them; they were my joy and my heart's delight, for I bear your name, LORD God Almighty" (Jeremiah 15:16). Scripture's use of food metaphors demonstrates the importance of ingesting God's Word, of making it a part of us. Scripture is not something merely to study or read but to be "eaten" by God's people. We read the Word, but we then pause to "chew on it" a while, meditating and reflecting on the meaning and application of what we've read (see Psalm 1:1-3). www.gotquestions.com People often look at the Bible as a bunch of fables, but in reality, it's encoded with deep spiritual meanings.

10. What is Jesus known for? He says in scriptures, "I am the way and the _____ and the _____ No one gets to the Father but by Me. John 14:16 Remember, if Jesus is the Word of God, He is the Truth (which is the Way (back to Eden), and the Life, which the Way (the obedience to the laws of God – not eating the fruit of this world) gives eternal Life. This is why Jesus uses the metaphor of his body being bread and his blood being wine when He is preparing to be the Passover, because He is the Word of God, or "bread" of Life.

11. After Adam and Eve fell by "eating" from the tree that God forbade them to eat from (which tree was that?) _____ they were cut off from which Tree? _____ Does a person get knowledge from eating? No. Adam and Eve partook in knowledge they were not supposed to have or were not ready to have. This idea is expounded upon in the Book of Enoch, when the angels taught women how to have miscarriages, use make-up and taught the men how to make weapons of war.

12. Why were they cut off from the Tree of Life?

_____ Gen. 3:23 And God said, Behold, Adam is become as one of us, to know good and evil, and now lest at any time he stretch forth his hand, and take of the Tree of Life and eat, and so he shall live forever." Therefore, God had to exile them from the land, from the presence of the tree that gives eternal life. Therefore, the two trees in Eden give us an understanding of the choices we have in this realm, to get back to that realm.

13. What did Adam and Eve do to cover their “nakedness”?

_____ What does their nakedness represent?

_____ Let's look at Revelation 3:17-18 to see what Jesus says, “Because you say, ‘I am rich, have become wealthy, and have need of nothing’ – and do not know that you are wretched, miserable, poor, blind, and naked – I counsel you to buy from Me gold refined in the fire, that you may be rich; and white garments, that you may be clothed, that the shame of your nakedness may not be revealed; and anoint your eyes with eye salve, that you may see.’

14. Therefore, the big picture is this: The two “trees” are the two choices we have in this realm. We can either follow the ways of the fallen tree, The Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil, or follow the way of the Tree of Life, which brings us back to the other realm. One is representative of Satan, who mixes good with evil in order to deceive, and one is representative of Jesus, which gives

15. When God found Adam and Eve in the garden and they were naked and had covered themselves, what did God do for them? _____ This was the first what?

_____. Here, we see the law, once again, right from the beginning – before it was ever given to man!

16. We are going to find out that the law of Yahweh brings blessings for obedience and _____ for disobedience. Let's look at the Old Testament. Deuteronomy 11:26-28

“Behold, I set before you today a blessing and a curse: the blessing, if you obey the commandments of the LORD your God which I command you today; and the curse if you do not obey the commandments of the LORD your God, but turn aside from the way which I command you today.....” Let's look at the New Testament (Covenant). Galatians 3:10-13 ¹⁰ For as many as are of the works of the law are under the curse (disobedience); for it is written, “Cursed is everyone who does not continue in all things which are written in the book of the law, to do them.” ¹¹ But that no one is justified by the law in the sight of God is evident, for “the just shall live by faith.” ¹² Yet the law is not of faith (the law is works), but “the man who does them shall live by them.”

¹³ Christ has redeemed us from the curse of the law (from our disobedience), having become a curse for us, for it is written, “Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree”,
Matthew 22:37-38 Jesus declared, “Love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.” This is the first and greatest commandment. Let’s look at what Jesus is talking about - how loving the LORD your God with all your heart and soul and mind is defined – Deuteronomy 26:16 “This day the LORD your God commands you to observe these statutes and judgments; therefore you shall be careful to observe them with all your heart and with all your soul. Today you have proclaimed the LORD to be your God, and that you will walk in His ways and keep His statutes, His commandments, and His judgments, and that you obey His voice. Also today the LORD has proclaimed you to be His special people, just as He promised you, that you should keep all His commandments, and that He will set you high above all nations which He has made in praise, in name, and in honor, and that you may be a holy people to the LORD your God, just as He has spoken.

17. In the beginning, God made a Covenant with Adam. Even though it doesn’t mention the word Covenant in Genesis – it does, however, in Hosea! Hosea 6:7 “Like Adam, they transgressed the Covenant...”. You will not find this in every translation, most say “Like man,” instead of Adam. However, this marks the _____ covenant! Let’s count the covenants until we get to the Messiah and why he had to come to atone for our sins once again, when God had already atoned for them in the Garden of Eden! #land #realms #husband #Father

III. CAIN AND ABEL

1. Cain and Abel present an _____
2. Cain's offering was not respected because the scriptures do not state that it was from his _____. Some say it was because Abel sacrificed an animal and Cain brought from the land. But: However, the scriptures tell us that Abel brought of his _____ Abel also brought of the firstborn of his flock and of their fat.
3. The curse or mark of Cain was put upon him because he did not repent or follow the law and he went out from the presence of the Lord. When a person is marked- they are utilized for a purpose. There is a mark from God and a mark from the beast.
4. In chapter 4 of Genesis – right before it explains the Giants and the Fallen Angels (we are going to get there (chapter 6 – when we get to Noah), we see something peculiar going on! Cain's offspring know how to make harps and psaltery, music instruments. They also are taught how to manufacture brass and iron. Who was the first to have these musical instruments? _____ Let's see in Ezekiel 28:13 "Thou has been in Eden, the garden of God; every precious stone was thy covering, the sardius, topaz, and the diamond, the beryl, the onyx and the jasper (these are all the stones of the future Ephod that priests where), sapphire, etc. and gold: the workmanship of thy timbrels and of thy pipes was prepared in thee in the day that thou was created." I find it interesting that Satan had this gift, and now it is seen in the line of Cain. This was all before the flood! You are going to see how the seed of Cain lives on and more importantly – where, when we do the Book of Revelation.

IV. NOAH

1. Noah is important to study because Chapter 6 in Genesis explains why we have demons in this world (realm)
2. Enoch was Noah's great-grandfather. He walked with God and did not die – he was taken (sickled is the word in Revelation). I assume he was taken because he did not deserve the coming wrath of God (the flood). I also assume, this is a type of _____ for the end times when people will be taken before the wrath of God (which are the Bowls - not to be confused with the Trumpets or what the scriptures call the tribulation in Revelation)! The Book of Enoch was found in the mountains of Qumran in 1947 along with the other Dead Sea Scrolls. I Now, the Dead Sea Scrolls are said to be over 2,000 years old and match up with the Septuagint or the Greek Old Testament. This finding fulfills a prophesy for end times. Remember, Jesus tells us in Matthew that we will not know the day or the hour of His second coming, but we will be given signs to know the “season” of the end times. Also, the Book of Enoch, states this in Chapter 1:1, “The words of the blessing of Enoch, with which he blessed the elect and righteous, who will be living in the day of tribulation, when all the wicked and godless are to be removed.” Enoch goes on to say in verse 2-9 concerning the end time people – I believe that's you and me, more prophesies.
3. Let's look at a clue that Jesus gives us in Matthew 24:37-39 about the end times and his second coming! “But as the days of _____ were, so also will the coming of the Son of Man be. For as in the days before the flood, they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, until the day that Noah entered the ark and did not know until the flood came and took them all away, so also will the coming of the Son of Man be.” There is a lot here, because a lot was happening in the days of Noah. Man was sinning in a way that we are today, because we have fallen away from His laws. 2 Thessalonians 2:3 “Let no one deceive you by any means; for that Day will not come unless the falling away comes first, and the man of lawlessness is revealed, the son of perdition...” Let's take a closer look at Noah's day and see what was going on!
4. Noah had three sons: _____ , _____ and _____
5. Why does the wrath or the flood happen? Modern day theology will have you believe that people were just sinful. But there was much more than that going on! We are told in Genesis Chapter 6 that in the time of Noah, the _____ saw that _____ were fair and took for them wives as they chose. The interesting part of all of this – The Book of Enoch explains this in further detail! Let's read Chapter 6 and 7 in Enoch! Yes – this account is in Chapter 6 in both Genesis and Enoch (the 7th generation).
6. Genesis 6:9 states: These are the generations of Noah: Noah was a just man and _____ in his generations, and Noah walked with God (this is the same description as was given to Enoch). What does perfect in his generations mean? _____

7. What is going on today? What are we doing with the gene pool? _____

8. You do not mess with God's creation – the genetic code! He made us in the image of Himself and that is not to be modified. The genetic code belongs to God. In fact, the law states not to even mingle
_____. Yet now, what do we have corrupting our food supply?

9. Another mystery is the dinosaurs. The book of Enoch tells us that the giants “began to sin against birds and beasts and reptiles and fish”. Why did they exist and now they are gone? I believe they were never meant to be. I think they were DNA manipulation and another reason the flood had to happen (just as the last Jurassic Park movie “tells” us – remember, movies mix lies with truth) and became a terror on this planet. _____. Genesis 3 “And between your seed and her Seed; He shall bruise your head, and you shall bruise His heel.”

11. Fun fact: To this day, nearly EVERY culture has a tradition of a global flood – videos to follow!

_____. Genesis 6:18 “But I will establish My covenant with you; and you shall go into the ark-you, your sons, your wife and your sons wives with you.”

16. The Law is introduced little by little. When do we see sacrifices after the flood? Right away! Genesis 8:20 “Then Noah built an altar to the Lord and took of every clean animal and of every clean bird, and offered burnt offerings on the altar.”

17. The important Laws are made known first (first being the Sabbath through Creation). The second are the food laws: Adam and Eve and the tree, also Noah and the 7 clean animals on the ark and then continues with Genesis 9:4 “But you shall not eat flesh with its life, that is, its blood. Surely for your lifeblood I will demand a reckoning;..... Whoever sheds man’s blood (the third is murder: punishable by death), by man his blood shall be shed; For in the image of God He made man.” Eye for an eye is established right here, and as in Acts, not eating flesh with blood. Acts spoke to NEW believers and gave the most important laws FIRST, as God does in Genesis. Let’s read Acts 15:29 “....that you abstain from things offered to idols, from blood, from things strangled, and from sexual immorality. If you keep yourselves from these, you will do well.” God always gives His laws gradually as to not overwhelm us!

18. We also see a curse on Ham’s lineage. What’s strange is that Ham does the deed, but Ham’s son Canaan is cursed for it. This does not follow the Law of God, so what is going on here? It is no surprise that Nimrod and the tower of Babel come through this line – which are the Canaanites. We are going to get into blood lines a little more down the road!

19. Next we jump to Abraham! Right after the flood, man is up to planning and plotting.
