2. Back Drop

Let's look at Revelation 20:1-3 and 20:7-8 What is the theme? “Deceive the **Nations** no more” – this is a clue as to where Satan's first round of deception is targeted. This is Jacob's Trouble, before the Millennial Reign. We are going to learn when the Bible speaks about nations and speaks about gentiles, they are two different groups of people, and it is GOD's way of telling us where they are!

1. What is the family line that is followed throughout the Old Testament?

Remember, the root word is Gene in Genesis, means there is a seed line and GOD is concerned with who is who or He never would have taken the time to meticulously document who was born to who.
