

Moses is given a prophesy about the Messiah: "I will raise them up a Prophet from among their brethren, like unto thee, and will put My words in His mouth; and He shall speak unto them all that I shall command Him. And it shall come to pass, that whosoever will not hearken unto My words which He shall speak in My name, I will require it of him." Deuteronomy 18:18-19 Let's read John 5:46 "For if you believed Moses, you would have believed Me, for he wrote about Me." Jesus reiterates this in Luke: "And beginning at Moses and all the prophets, he expounded unto them in all the scriptures the things concerning Himself."
- 12. This gives a whole new meaning to "Think not that I've come to abolish the law or the prophets, but to fulfill them. For I tell you truly, until heaven and earth pass away, not a single jot, not a tittle, not a stroke of a pen, will disappear from the Law until everything is accomplished. So then, whoever breaks one of the least of these commandments (which includes the 4<sup>th</sup>) and teaches others to do likewise will be called least in the kingdom of heaven, but whoever practices and teaches them will be called great in the kingdom of heaven."
